

## Call for proposals for short videos presenting methods for improving ergonomics

The Nordic Ergonomic and Human Factor Society (NES) call for proposals for short video material presenting practical methods for improving ergonomics. Applicants can apply for up to €2000.

The video should present a method for improving ergonomics, its specific purpose and explain how to use the method. The target audience for the videos are ergonomic and human factor professionals in the Nordic countries.

The proposal and video must be in English. The video may later be subtitled, or audio dubbed in a national language if the national society wish to do so.

Copyright(s) for the video must be transferred to NES. The applicant must ensure that the video does not contain copyrighted material.

A proposal should be no more than 1000 words and contain a description of the method and how it will be presented e.g. oral presentation using blackboard, animation, video of a case with explanation etc.

### Evaluation

Each application will be assessed based on its originality, quality and fitness for the target audience.

The decision of the NES board is final and cannot be appealed.
